## Women's FEST Comes to Rehoboth April 7-10 Largest Women's Event in the Mid-Atlantic

Rehoboth Beach DE: February 20, 2022—CAMP Rehoboth's Women's FEST will bring the best in national and regional entertainment and special events to Rehoboth Beach April 7-10 for what has become the largest event specifically for women in the Mid-Atlantic region. Since its inception as a Women's Conference and Weekend in 2001, Women's FEST has become a hugely popular spring tradition that offers music, speakers, sports, dancing, and fun. The concept is best explained by the FEST initials: Fun, Entertainment, Spring, Tradition. CAMP Rehoboth is a local organization that supports the health of the local community and the fair and equitable treatment of everyone, no matter what their sexual orientation or gender identity.

Women's Fest will start with a bang on Thursday, April 7, 7 p.m. with Georgette Krenkel's Kick Off Party at the Rehoboth Beach Convention Center. This free event will provide an opportunity to meet, greet, and dance to the music of DJ Jamie Fox. There will also be a singles lounge and a free photo booth by Fortier Photography.

Friday night, April 8, superstar Chely Wright, an American country music singer and LGBTQ activist, and opener and Delaware native Christine Havrilla will take the stage at the Rehoboth Beach Convention Center. Doors open at 6:45 p.m. for FEST Pass holders and sponsors, and at 7:15 p.m. for general seating.

Then, on Saturday, April 9, the Funny Girlz show will take place at 7:30 p.m. in the Rehoboth Beach Convention Center. The hilarious trio of Lisa Koch, Vickie Shaw, and Roxanna Ward will perform stand-up, sing, play piano, and entertain.

Popular local author and humorist Fay Jacobs will be back with her hilarious one-woman show, "Still Aging Gracelessly," on Sunday, April 10 at 3 p.m.

Women's FEST will also bring exciting new shows from singer and songwriter Regina Sayles, returning to FEST by popular demand. Merging her musical abilities with a love for performance, Sayles blends various genres such as pop, jazz, soul, and country. She will be joined by Sug Daniels, making her debut to the FEST stage with her mix of folk, R&B, and lo-fi alternatives to create personal and tender music interlaced with messages of truth and positive change.
