Scholarship Guidelines for Year One

This scholarship is available to high school juniors and seniors attending Delaware schools. The winner will receive \$500 towards their higher education.

Submissions

Students are encouraged to write an essay on the importance of LGBTQ Pride.

Essays must be no more than 750 words. Essays are to be written in 12 pt Arial font, have one-inch margins, and be single spaced.

No identifying information (e.g., writer's name) should appear on the essay. A cover sheet which includes a copy of the applicant's school ID, their name, address, and contact information must accompany the submission.

Timeline

- Essays must be submitted to info@camprehoboth.com by May 8
- Winner will be notified by May 25
- The winning essay will be published in the Pride issue of Letters from CAMP Rehoboth (release date: June 17th)
